**THANK YOU** for your continued support of Golf fore Education - the community collaboration between Project MANA, American Association of University Women (AAUW) and the Incline Schools Academic Excellence Foundation (ISAEF). The event, held in June 2007, raised \$131,831 in gross revenues and, after the subtraction of minimal expenses of \$44,179, resulted in \$87,652 in net profits. The net profits were distributed, per organizing committee agreement, with \$17,530 going to Project MANA, \$35,061 going to the AAUW and \$35,061 going to ISAEF.

As you can see, **your support** significantly assisted in our collaborative endeavor to raise money for educating our community. **AAUW**, this past year, awarded six scholarships with a total value of \$12,000. to graduating seniors at Incline High School. In addition to this, they awarded another \$10,500 to previous graduates to continue their higher education. And, in addition to the aforementioned, AAUW awarded a total of \$9,200 in grants to Arts for Schools, Children's Cabinet (Homework Help Club), Pet Network (Children's Humane Education Program) Tahoe Forest Hospice, Tahoe Women's Services and University of Nevada at Reno Math Camp. **Project MANA** has provided \$3,200 for the 'Glow Grow, Go' curriculum, \$4,400 for the Second Grade nutrition education for 80 students, \$3,000 for Nutrition Snack during Testing Week for 480 students at the Incline Elementary School and \$3,950 for the 'Kids Can Cook' Program which reaches out to latch key children. **ISAEF** deposited its share of the proceeds to the Endowment Fund which allowed it to reach their first \$100,000 goal on the way to creating a \$1.5 million endowment.

**Your support** has allowed each of the collaborating agencies to experience significant success this past year in achieving their individual goals and missions. They could not have done it without **your support** and we **THANK YOU** from the bottom of our hearts. We know that you have lots of choices of where your hard earned discretionary funds go and to what charities you support but it is our sincere hope that you will continue your generous support of this collaborative event especially since you know exactly where and what your funds benefited.

And speaking of opportunities, we are very excited to share with you, as an early announcement, that our 2008 Golf Fore Education event is scheduled for June 21, 22 and 23, 2008! The activities commence with our reception at Patterson Hall (on the campus of Sierra Nevada College) the evening of June 21, followed by golf and dinner at the Championship Golf Course and Chateau, respectively, on June 22, and then, on June 23, we conclude our event with a day of golf at Montreux Golf and Country Club.
